Hello everyone,

As you are aware, the college has been closed the past several days due to the fires in the area and we did not meet for class this past week. This closure greatly impacts our course materials that were to be covered this week. As a result, I am making the following changes to the end of semester exam materials and schedules. Please note these in your preparation for the final exam and let me know if you have any questions.

1. The lab final exam that was to be completed last Tuesday will take place on Tuesday (12/12/17) from 5:30-7:30 pm, in place of the scheduled lecture final exam.
2. The lecture final exam will take place on Thursday (12/14/17) at the same time and will cover Chapters 9, 10 and 11 (pages 1-5 of notes). These are the sections we covered in class before this week and you are responsible for knowing for the final exam.
3. The exit ticket on Chapters 10 (due this week) can be turned in at the beginning of the lecture final exam on 12/14/17. In addition, I will also post an exit ticket to include questions on the sections of Chapter 11 that we covered in class and you are responsible for the final exam. This exit ticket will also be due at the beginning of the final exam.
4. The exit tickets for Chapters 9, 10 and 11 will be graded on the basis of 40 points and will be added to your quiz grade earned in class to make a total of 120 points as described in the syllabus.
5. The campus will be open beginning tomorrow and tutoring and other services will be available as preparation for the final exams. Tutoring will be available on Saturday and Sunday from 11:30 am to 8:30 pm in LRC building on the main campus. I myself will be in office tomorrow from 11 am to 2 pm, if you want to visit my office and ask questions. I will also be available next week during the final exam week.

Although this unexpected disruption has impacted our class, I am hoping that these changes make the studying for the final exam more directed and as a result more successful.
